APPROPRIATIONS BILL – S.18-A-003



Concerning the purchase of food and promotional materials for the Student Town Hall to be hosted by the Undergraduate Student Government (USG)

1. **Whereas** USG representatives get multiple student-facing opportunities to speak about ideas, initiatives and University-wide issues during the annual two weeks of campaign season, and
2. **Whereas** during those two weeks, candidates run on platforms that they plan to accomplish on behalf of student interests, and
3. **Whereas** it is critical to the appropriate function of this USG to always be transparent with students and give students opportunities to hold their officials accountable to the progress of their platforms outside of the campaign season time frame, and
4. **Whereas** USG will provide a new opportunity for student outreach and engagement this fall, hosting a Student Town Hall on the fifth day of October in the year 2017, from 5:00-6:30 p.m. in Tangeman University Center (TUC) Great Hall, and
5. **Whereas** during this event, members of USG, including the Undergraduate Trustee, Exec, Chief Justice, At-Large Senators, Board Senators, and Tribunal Senators will have a chance to address the student body, field questions, and hear student concerns
6. **Therefore be it appropriated** that \$750.00, plus a 10% overrun of \$75.00 be allocated from the outreach line item, to purchase light snacks and refreshments from Classic Fare Catering, as well as promotional materials for the event.
